

Red Feather Mountain Library District

Policy for the Reconsideration of Library Materials

Revised and approved by the Red Feather Mountain Library District Board of Trustees on May 27, 2020.

Materials are added to the Library's collection, either by purchase or donation, through guidelines noted within the Library's *Collection Management Policy*. The removal of materials is determined by the Library's *Deselection of Library Materials Policy*.

If a Library user, determined by the holding of a current Red Feather library card for at least three-month's duration, believes that a given item

has been added to the collection in error
or, is inappropriate within the Library
or, is otherwise inappropriately placed within the Library's collections.

That individual has the right to appeal the presence or placement of that item through the Library's written *Reconsideration of Materials Procedure*.
