Red Feather Mountain Library District Emergency Closing Policy

1-The Red Feather Lakes Community Library is a public service entity; therefore, patrons expect the library to be open even in severe weather or when building functions are impaired.

2-However, the library may close (or postpone opening) when weather conditions, local community operations, or the state of the facility itself make the library difficult to safely reach or use.

3-The decision to close or postpone opening the library is at the discretion of the Library Director (or the Librarian-in-charge in the absence of the director).

4-In the event of closure, scheduled employees will be compensated as if there were no loss of service.
